Steps to Apply to Fayetteville Technical Community College

A non-degree seeking student is one who wants to take a few classes, but does not intend to seek a degree, diploma, or certificate.

Note: Non-degree seeking students are not eligible for financial aid or veterans benefits.

Steps To Apply

1. Complete an [Admissions Application](#)

Enter “Special Student” (T90990) as your program of study/major.

Make sure all areas are complete for “Residency Information” because this will determine whether you are an in-state or out-of-state student.

2. Financial Aid

Non-degree seeking students are not eligible for financial aid or veterans benefits.

3. Submit Your Transcripts

If you are registering for a course with a FTCC prerequisite, you must provide official or unofficial transcripts to verify you meet the requirements. To determine if a course has prerequisites, view [Course Descriptions](#).
