## 2. Complete an [Admissions Application](#)

Make sure all areas are complete for “Residency Information” because this will determine whether you are an in-state or out-of-state student.

## 3. Apply for [Financial Aid](#)

Complete a [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#) to find out if you are eligible for financial aid.

## 4. Submit Your Transcripts

### High School Transcripts

An official high school or GED transcript is required for program approval and financial aid. Applicants who have graduated from an accredited college or university with an associate degree or higher may not be required to submit high school transcripts.

Contact Admissions at 910-678-8473 to check your status.

- High school transcripts must show your graduation date.
- Home-schooled students must submit a copy of the home school's approved registration from the state in which they are registered and an official sealed and notarized transcript including the graduation date.

## College Transcripts

Submit official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended in order to have your credits evaluated for potential transfer credit.

- Grades at other institutions will not be calculated in your FTCC GPA.
- Certain Health programs will use outside credit to calculate competitive points.

All transcripts must be official, sealed documents submitted by your school to:
